

DAY 1 · Depart U.S.

Fly to San José, where you'll be joined by our fellow travelers who took the optional pretrip extension to Costa Rica's Pacific Coast: Drake Bay & Corcovado National Park.

DAY 2 · Coffee plantation · Muelle

Visit a family-owned coffee finca (plantation) and learn why locals call the coffee bean the grano d'oro, or "golden seed." Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Dinner.

DAY 3 · Muelle · Cruise the Río Frío

Travel to Costa Rica's northern border, near the Caño Negro Wildlife Refuge. Then, board a small boat to explore the Río Frío, an inland waterway.

DAY 4 · Muelle · A Day in the Life of Santa Esperanza village · GCF visit · Home-Hosted Lunch

DAY 5 · Lake Arenal boat ride · Monteverde

Enjoy a boat ride around Lake Arenal. We'll see the volcano in the distance and the lake shore—cruising along, we may spot some howler monkeys. Continue to Monteverde, located near the town of Santa Elena.

DAY 6 · Monteverde Cloud Forest · Controversial Topic: Sexual education in Costa Rica · Optional Forest Canopy Tour

Begin the day learning about a **Controversial Topic**: sexual education in Costa Rica. Later, walk through the 26,000-acre wildlife sanctuary of Monteverde Cloud Forest, which protects hundreds of species of animals. This afternoon, take an optional Forest Canopy Ride, flying from tree to tree via zip-line.

DAY 7 · Hanging Bridges tour · Farm visit

Take a Hanging Bridges tour and explore the forest from a unique vantage point. Then, we'll visit a local farm to have lunch. Later, explore Monteverde on your own.

DAY 8 • Manuel Antonio National Park • Mangrove tour

Depart for Manuel Antonio National Park. En route, stop at Hacienda Nosavar to take a Mangrove tour, learning about how they provide important nesting grounds for birds and perhaps spotting crocodiles.

DAY 9 · Rainforest spices tour · Optional evening nature walk

Tour the Villa Vanilla Spice Plantation, an organic spice farm. Explore the grounds before partaking in a tasting of spice-infused treats. Later, embark on an optional night walk through the forest.

DAY 10 • Manuel Antonio National Park • San Gerardo de Dota

Explore Manuel Antonio National Park, a critical habitat for migrating birds. The park is also one of only two habitats in the country for the endangered squirrel monkey, and we'll keep an eye out for one as we walk along the nature trails. Later, depart for San Gerardo de Dota.

DAY 11 · San Gerardo de Dota · Morning quetzal search

Explore San Gerardo de Dota, resting in a pastoral valley carpeted with apple and peach trees. Early this morning, we'll set out to spot the resplendent quetzal.

DAY 12 · San José

Head to San José for a sightseeing tour. Begin at the Parque Nacional, which celebrates the country's history. Then, visit historic plazas, markets, and iconic buildings—including the *Plaza de la Cultura*. Tonight, wish each other *adios* during a Farewell Dinner.

DAY 13 · Return to U.S.

Transfer to the airport for your flight home, or begin a post-trip extension to Costa Rica's Caribbean Coast: Tortuguero National Park.
