

APPLICATION FOR MENTOR/MENTEE PROGRAM 2024

This program is designed to provide an opportunity for members (Mentees) to develop their skills in photography through a series of classroom lectures, one-on-one sessions with their Mentors, weekly assignments and assistance in post camera processing. The duration of the program is approximately ten (10) weeks. (January through March 2024.

The Mentor will also work with their Mentee to assist them become experienced in areas of their interest for future development e.g. Portraits, Still Life photography, Street Photography, Animals, Evening/Sunset/Night Photography etc. It is not expected that the Mentor will be an expert in one or more of these areas. Assignments are not expected to be a financial burden on either the Mentor/Mentee. Costs for field trips, gas, entrance fees, meals, etc. should be negotiated in advance when driving outside Sun City West.

Mentors are asked to:

Attend several class room sessions with their Mentee and discuss their understanding of what had been presented. There will be Feedback Sessions at the beginning of the previous week's learning material.

Provide one-on-one assistance each week to the Mentee to guide them to complete assignments;

Provide assistance with basic Photoshop Elements editing,

Demonstrate how images can be printed and mounted (each mentee is allowed one 16 X 20 print & mounting included in their registration fee).

Guide their Mentee in preparing for Critiques, a group solo show and a Friday Program at the Stardust Theatre.

Attend both Critique Sessions and discuss comments, or suggestions that are made after the session.

Be a source of constant encouragement, advice and information to develop their skills;

Review with their Mentee areas of specific interest they have and discuss what they have learned and how it can be applied in preparations for their trips, or other areas of interest.

- 1. Are you willing and able to spend ten weeks (Jan. through March) providing guidance to a Mentee in achieving certain goals and objectives in photography? Y or N
